Road Safety

Following the near miss with Ann (our school crossing patrol) last week, her manager spent some time this week observing what happens in the morning outside school. He noted two very concerning and potentially dangerous occurrences taking place. The first was to do with where cars are parking. There were a number of cars parking on the double yellow lines on the bend of Moss Lane and Dodds Lane. This meant Ann could not be clearly seen by traffic and cars could not safely pass each other. The second concern is that there were a number of drivers who did not stop to drop off their children; they simply opened their door and children jumped out whilst they were waiting for Ann to cross others on the road. This meant Ann was also trying to watch children further down the road as she was worried about them jumping out on such a busy road. We know it is busy at drop off and collection but please ensure you are doing everything in your power to prevent accidents or near misses happening. Park safely and sensibly - it is illegal to park on double yellow lines. We all need to look out for each other so help our community to stay safe.
