Admission to Nursery Procedures

Northway Nursery has 52 part time places. There are two options that parents can choose from, each providing 15 hours provision:

Start of week: Mon & Tues 9.00 – 3.00pm, Wed 8.50-11.50am

End of week: Wed 12.30- 3.30pm, Thurs, Fri 9.00 – 3.00pm

Children in the Nursery follow the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum. This carefully structured and balanced curriculum enables children to learn through a rich variety of play activities which promote the development of a wide range of skills and encourages exploration and curiosity. Self-awareness, self-control and a sense of responsibility are fostered through opportunities for social interaction with others.

Parents considering sending their child to our Nursery should complete an application form from the school office or downloaded from the school website. Children are admitted in the term after their third birthday, if the number of applicants exceeds the number of spaces, places will be allocated by the following criteria:

First: Children who are in public care and are expected to still be in public care when admitted to the school.

Second: Pupils with a statement of special educational needs who the authority have named this school for provision.

Third: Children who have a brother or sister living in the same house who attend Northway Primary School and are expected to attend at the time of admission.

Fourth: Child's date of birth (older children will be given priority).

Fifth: Children who are likely to attend Reception.

Sixth: Date Nursery application form was received.
